请各成员国指派一名或几名参加者代表政府参加这次活动。大力鼓励各成员国确定合适的女性参加者。

原子能机构一般不承担参加者参加活动的差旅费和其他费用。但原子能机构可支配有限资金，用于帮助支付某些参加者的参加费用。根据具体申请通常可向每个国家的一名参加者提供此种援助，条件是原子能机构认为该参加者将为这次活动做出重要贡献。财政资助申请应在指派参加者时利用随附的“补助金申请表”（C表）提出。

应注意，原子能机构对个人财产遭受的任何损坏或损失概不赔偿。原子能机构也不向原子能机构活动的参加者提供健康保险。因此，个人应做私人保险安排。但是，原子能机构将就明显因为原子能机构工作而引起的事故和疾病提供保险。

Introduction

The Regional School on Nuclear Security offers early career professionals from the Asia and the Pacific region the opportunity to learn, understand and explore a broad spectrum of topics in nuclear security and enhance their skills in the field.

The School will consist of a series of lectures and practical exercises, designed to incorporate the acquired knowledge into national planning and procedures to protect against threats to nuclear security.

This School is part of a series of international and regional schools on nuclear security that the IAEA implements in many regions and in a variety of languages.

Objectives

This School is designed to provide early career professionals from the Asia and the Pacific region

with the fundamental knowledge of nuclear security necessary to understand the international requirements in this area and the measures to be taken, in order to meet any obligations under the international nuclear security legal framework.

Target Audience

Participants should be early career professionals from the Asia and the Pacific region, ideally with 1-3 years of professional experience, working at an institution within their respective country with responsibilities for ensuring some aspects of nuclear security. Candidates should have a specific interest in pursuing careers which would benefit from knowledge of nuclear security.

Working Language

English

Participation and Registration

All persons wishing to participate in the event have to be designated by an IAEA Member State or should be members of organizations that have been invited to attend.

In order to be designated by an IAEA Member State, participants are requested to send the **Participation Form (Form A)** to their competent national authority (e.g. Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) for onward transmission to the IAEA by **15 June 2020**. Participants who are members of an organization invited to attend are requested to send the **Participation Form (Form A)** through their organization to the IAEA by above deadline.

Selected participants will be informed in due course on the procedures to be followed with regard to administrative and financial matters.

Please note that the IAEA is in a transition phase to manage the entire registration process for all regular programme events electronically through the new InTouch+ (<https://intouchplus.iaea.org>) facility, which is the improved and expanded successor to the InTouch platform that has been used in recent years for the IAEA's technical cooperation events. Through InTouch+, prospective participants will be able to apply for events and submit all required documents online. National authorities will be able to use InTouch+ to review and approve these applications. Expenditures and Grants

No registration fee is charged to participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the event. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Upon specific request, such assistance may be offered to normally one participant per country, provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant will make an important contribution to the event.

The application for financial support should be made using the **Grant Application Form (Form C)** which has to be stamped, signed and submitted by the competent national authority to the IAEA together with the **Participation Form (Form A)** by **15 June 2020**.

Visas

Participants who require a visa to enter Indonesia should submit the necessary application as soon as possible to the nearest diplomatic or consular representative of Indonesia.

Additional Requirements

As a pre-requisite to admission to the School, all applicants will be asked to complete IAEA introductory e-learning modules on several topics in nuclear security.

Participants are required to submit their completed OEH forms with their Participation Forms. Incomplete submissions will not be considered for the event.
