请成员国指派一名参加者参加这次活动。大力鼓励各成员国确定女性参加者。

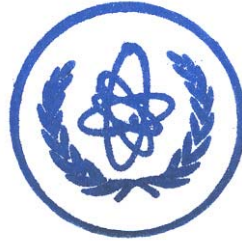
原子能机构一般不承担参加者参加活动的差旅费和其他费用。但原子能机构可支配有限资金，用于帮助支付某些参加者的参加费用。根据具体申请通常可向每个国家的一名参加者提供此种援助，条件是原子能机构认为该参加者将为这次活动做出重要贡献。如随附“资料单”所示，应不迟于 **2025 年 6 月 5 日** 通过 InTouch+ 平台提交财政支助的申请。

应注意，原子能机构对个人财产遭受的任何损坏或损失概不赔偿。原子能机构也不向原子能机构活动的参加者提供健康保险。因此，个人应做私人保险安排。但是，原子能机构将就明显因为原子能机构工作而引起的事故和疾病提供保险。

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The Secretariat of the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) presents its compliments to the IAEA's Member States and has the honour to draw their attention to the **Hands-On Training on Inspection of Equipment for Nuclear Security at Facilities Using Nuclear or Other Radioactive Material** (hereinafter referred to as "event") at the Nuclear Security Training and Demonstration Centre (NSTDC) in Seibersdorf, Austria, from **8 to 12 September 2025**.

The purpose of the event is to enhance the knowledge and understanding of domestic inspectors on performing inspections of physical protection systems at nuclear facilities using nuclear or other radioactive material.

The attached Information Sheet provides further details of the event.

The event will be held in English.

Member States are invited to designate one participant for this event. Member States are strongly encouraged to identify women participants.

The IAEA is generally not in a position to bear the travel and other costs of participants in the event. The IAEA has, however, limited funds at its disposal to help meet the cost of attendance of certain participants. Upon specific request, such assistance may be offered to normally one participant per country, provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant will make an important contribution to the event. The application for financial support should be made via the InTouch+ platform not later than **5 June 2025**, as indicated in the enclosed Information Sheet.

It should be noted that compensation is not payable by the IAEA for any damage to or loss of personal property. The IAEA also does not provide health insurance coverage for participants in IAEA events. Arrangements for private insurance coverage on an individual basis should therefore be made. The IAEA will, however, provide insurance coverage for accidents and illnesses that clearly result from any work performed for the IAEA.

Designations should be submitted to the IAEA via the InTouch+ platform (<https://intouchplus.iaea.org>) through the competent national authority (Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) not later than **5 June 2025**, as indicated in the enclosed Information Sheet.

The Scientific Secretary of the event will liaise with the participants directly concerning further arrangements, including travel details, as appropriate, once the official designations have been received.

Information Sheet

Introduction

The IAEA established a Nuclear Security Training and Demonstration Centre (NSTDC) at Seibersdorf. In the area of physical protection of nuclear and other radioactive material and facilities, NSTDC focused on providing hands-on training for States, based on official requests, in support of complex projects that require specialized technical infrastructure and for capacity building of States developing new facilities or expanding facilities using nuclear and other radioactive material. The Hands-On Training on Inspection of Equipment for Nuclear Security at Facilities Using Nuclear or Other Radioactive Material will assist Member States in building competence in performing inspections of physical protection systems at facilities using the equipment in NSTDC.

Objectives

To provide participants with basic knowledge and understanding on conducting regulatory inspections of physical protection systems at facilities using nuclear or other radioactive material.

Target Audience

Staff from the regulatory bodies, other competent authorities or organizations responsible for performing inspections of physical protection systems at nuclear facilities. Event is open to 20 participants.

Working Language(s)

English

Participation and Registration

All persons wishing to participate in the event have to be designated by an IAEA Member State or should be members of organizations that have been invited to attend.

In order to be designated by an IAEA Member State or invited organization, participants are requested to submit their application via the InTouch+ platform (<https://intouchplus.iaea.org>) to the competent national authority (Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Permanent Mission to the IAEA or National Atomic Energy Authority) or organization for onward transmission to the IAEA by **5 June 2025**, following the registration procedure in InTouch+:

1. Access the InTouch+ platform (<https://intouchplus.iaea.org>):

- Persons with an existing NUCLEUS account can sign in to the platform with their username and password;
- Persons without an existing NUCLEUS account can register [here](#).

2. Once signed in, prospective participants can use the InTouch+ platform to:

- Complete or update their personal details under ‘Complete Profile’ and upload the relevant supporting documents;
- Search for the relevant event under the ‘My Eligible Events’ tab;
- Select the Member State or invited organization they want to represent from the drop-down menu entitled ‘Designating Authority’ (if an invited organization is not listed, please contact InTouchPlus.Contact-Point@iaea.org);
- If applicable, indicate whether financial support is requested and complete the relevant information (this is not applicable to participants from invited organizations);
- Based on the data input, the InTouch+ platform will automatically generate the Participation Form (Form A) and/or the Grant Application Form (Form C);
- Submit their application.

Once submitted through the InTouch+ platform, the application, together with the auto-generated form(s), will be transmitted automatically to the required authority for approval. If approved, the application, together with the applicable form(s), will automatically be sent to the IAEA through the online platform.

NOTE: The application for financial support should be made, together with the submission of the application, by **5 June 2025**.

Selected participants will be informed in due course on the procedures to be followed with regard to administrative and financial matters.

Upon specific request, such assistance may be offered to normally one participant per country, provided that, in the IAEA's view, the participant will make an important contribution to the event.

Visas

Participants who require a visa to enter Austria should submit the necessary application to the nearest diplomatic or consular representative of Austria at least four weeks before they travel to Austria. Since Austria is a Schengen State, persons requiring a visa will have to apply for a Schengen visa. In States where Austria has no diplomatic mission, visas can be obtained from the consular authority of a Schengen Partner State representing Austria in the country in question.

Additional Information

Six or more months after completion of training events, participants will be required to complete a short survey on the use of acquired knowledge and skills or a change in attitudes. This will assist the Division of Nuclear Security in understanding the impact of its work and will guide future assistance.

Organization

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Subsequent correspondence on scientific matters should be sent to the Scientific Secretary/Secretaries and correspondence on other matters related to the event to the Administrative Secretary.
